R100,000 REWARD FOR INFORMATION LEADING TO THE ARREST AND CONVICTION OF THE PERSON/S BEHIND THE SENSELESS MURDER OF MALCOLM XOLANI CHILI

Durban, South Africa – July 15, 2024 – The family of **Malcolm Xolani Chili**, in conjunction with the Justice for Xolani Campaign, is seeking the media's support in reaching as many people as possible to help find the murderer(s) responsible for the brutal and senseless killing of Malcolm Xolani Chili.

Malcolm Xolani Chili, affectionately known as "Flex," was not just a man but a symbol of strength, resilience, and the relentless pursuit of justice. Born on May 14, 1981, in Durban, Xolani's life was tragically cut short on February 13, 2024, in a senseless act of violence. **He was shot 16 times in New Germany** while returning home from work, leaving behind a devastated family and community.

Xolani's journey was marked by triumphs, challenges, and unwavering determination. Born to Malcolm Daniel Thamsanqa Chili and Maria Nthabeleng in Kwa-Mashu, Xolani's spirit thrived amidst the vibrant culture of Durban. He pursued his education at Cato Manor Technical College, Swinton Technical College, and Durban University of Technology, specializing in Motor Mechanics Engineering.

Xolani was a Principal Engineer at MAXE (Pty) Ltd, a devoted husband, and a loving father to his three children. His hobbies, from spinning cars to fishing and cooking, reflected a man who embraced life with passion and joy. Xolani's artistic soul found expression in rap music, notably as part of the rap group Hidden Prophecy. In the neighbourhood watch forum of New Germany, Durban, he was a proactive participant, symbolizing his commitment to community safety.

The Justice for Xolani Campaign was born out of this tragedy. The campaign seeks not only to bring those responsible to justice but also to empower men to speak out against toxic relationships. Xolani's fight did not end with his death; instead, it ignited a movement for change.

Xolani's name, rooted in the Nguni languages, particularly Zulu, translates to "forgive" or "be forgiven." It is a name that echoes the spirit of reconciliation and embodies the transformative power of forgiveness. As we remember Malcolm Xolani Chili, let us celebrate the richness of his life, the warmth of his spirit, and the enduring impact he had on all who were fortunate enough to know him. In this time of profound loss, we come together to honour the legacy of a remarkable individual whose memory will forever live on in our hearts.

We are offering a reward of R100,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the individual(s) responsible for this heinous crime. 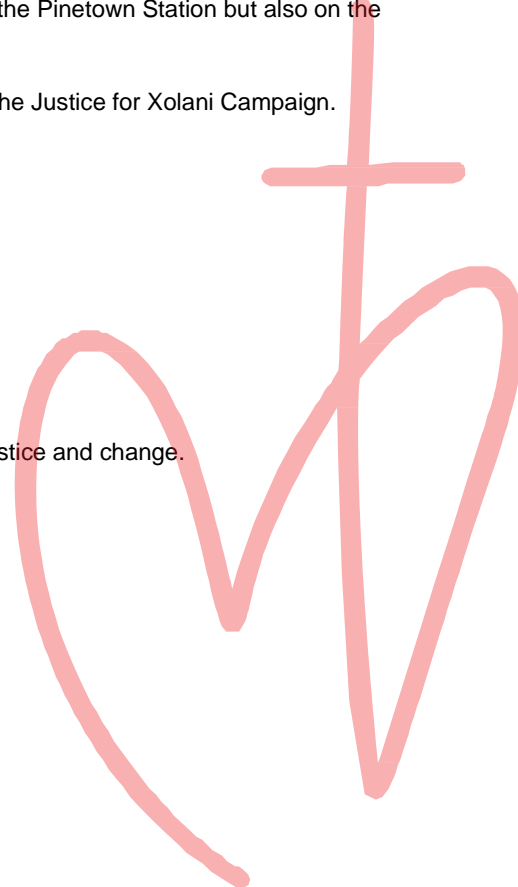
